

Drop-Outs: Last minute/in-the-event-of engine or boat failure, family emergency, job dictates, etc, the entry fee less \$10.00 will be tendered.

Cancellations: Due to adverse conditions (gale, tsunami, etc.); entry fees in full will be reimbursed.

Minimum Entries: Three boats for Power and two boats for Sail.

Prizes: For HYC Tournaments, all entry monies will be paid out, less the \$10.00/boat Overhead Cost.

Fishing Times: Start Fishing at 12:01a.m Saturday and be passing the Ala Wai Fuel Dock by 5:00p.m on the last day of event. Stop Fishing when you want, but you **MUST** be back and passing the Fuel Dock No-Later-Than 5:00p.m ..the fuel dock is 'the finish line'

Conditions: You may start from many harbor, but most come by water with entered boat to the HYC Aloha Dock for weighing; temporary mooring available per availability.

Season's Points Trophy: For HYC Members only, best 5 out of 7 events; excludes Juniors Fishing Tournament.

All skippers are responsible for their decision to fish and crew and guest safety, not the HYC; proof of liability insurance required; VHF radio required

HYC Club Fishing Rules

- Jungle Rules: No line size, multiple anglers, hand-lining are OK
- Mitch's Sushi and Senoritas will have their own set of rules; modified I GFA rules.
- Live or dead bait is allowed, no live bait in bait-wells before the start.
- No bang sticks, guns, or harpoons are to be used.
- Birds under 12' in length are legal, no green or blue sticks.
- Sail boats may pull lines from their backstays or running rigging.
- No bottom fishing but jigging is allowed with or without bait.
- No mutilation rule, large fish may be cut to fit into the fish box or to transport.
- Minimum Weights:
 - Marlin - 30 lbs
 - Spearfish - 20 lbs
 - 10 lbs for Ahi, Mahi, Ono, Aku, Kawakawa, Uku, Uua, Rainbow Runner, and Kaku

Protests: Limited to the day of the event, RC Power to decide.
